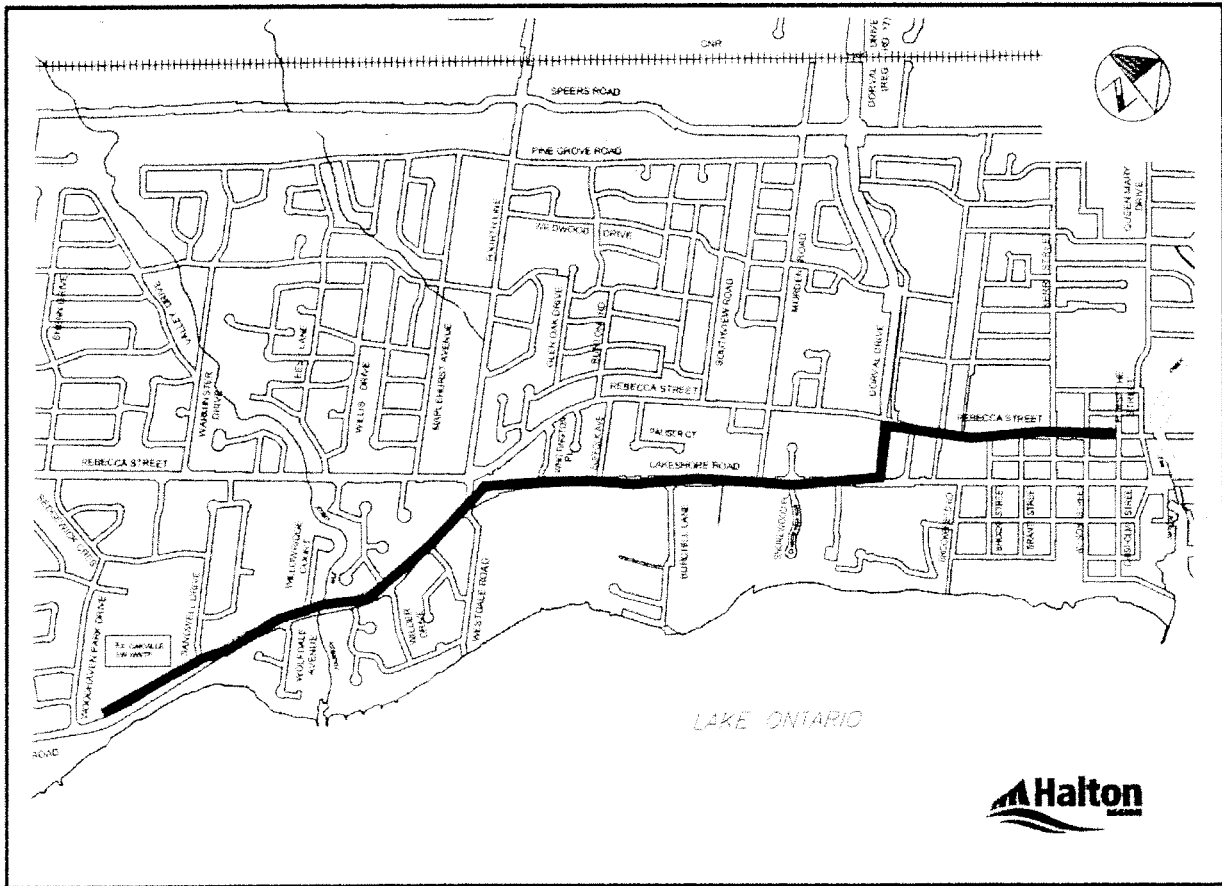

RE: NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION
Rebecca Street Deep Trunk Wastewater Main from the Oakville Southwest
Wastewater Treatment Plant to Forsythe Street, Wards 2 & 3, Town of Oakville,
Our File: PR-2869

Commencing fall of 2015, Halton Region will begin installation of a wastewater trunk main on Rebecca Street, Dorval Drive and Lakeshore Road. This work is to support the Oakville Urban Growth Centre and to alleviate existing capacity constraints. Watermain rehabilitation and replacement will also take place on Rebecca Street from Kerr Street to Forsythe Street.



The contractor for this project is Drainstar Contracting Ltd. with project administration by Cole Engineering Ltd. Construction is expected to be completed by winter 2016. The contractor will commence the project on Rebecca Street from Felan Avenue to Forsythe Street initially.

Utilities such as Union Gas, Hydro and Bell Canada may have already started to locate and mark out their existing infrastructure to prepare for this construction. Please do not disturb these marker stakes or paint markings; they will be removed by contract staff in due course.

Project Related Information and Recommendations:

- **Traffic Delays** – The project may cause traffic delays, lane shifts or lane restrictions. We will make every effort to minimize any potential inconvenience and provide advance notice when disruptions will occur. Police and emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.
- **Road Closures** - Please be advised that Halton Region will require local road closures on the following streets during the construction of the wastewater main:
 - Forsythe Street from Head Street to Rebecca Street;
 - West Lynn Road from Tilford Road to Lakeshore Road;
 - Westdale Road from The Stables to Lakeshore Road;
 - Sandwell Drive at Lakeshore Road.

A Notice of Road Closure will be delivered to area residence once the construction has moved into the affected areas and will provide additional information on the length of closure and a preferred detour route. We will make every effort to complete the construction work as quickly as possible to minimize the impact of the road closure.

- **Driveway Access** - During the project, direct access to your driveway may be restricted for short periods of time. You will be notified in advance of any planned restrictions.
- **Waste Collection** - Your garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up on your regularly scheduled day. It is the contractor's responsibility to move your garbage and recycling to a location where our collection vehicles can pick them up. Please mark your house number on your containers or bins to help with identification.
- **Truck Traffic** – At times you will notice increased truck traffic in the construction area. Please be aware and use extra caution while driving.
- **Vibration** – You may experience some vibration due to the work being done. As a precaution, we recommend that you remove or secure objects on shelves and walls. Vibration monitoring has been included as part of the contract and will be conducted at key locations along the proposed alignment.
- **Mail Delivery** – We don't anticipate any changes or delays to mail delivery to your property. If there are any changes, you will be notified in advance.
- **Tree Protection** –The Contractor will be responsible to co-ordinate with an arborist and Town of Oakville Municipal Tree Inspector on the installation of the tree protection barriers around tree(s) in affected locations as required by the Town of Oakville, Tree Protection Policy and bylaws.

- **Noise** – You may experience noise as a result of construction. Work will be scheduled in accordance with local noise bylaws.
- **Lawn Irrigation System** - If you have a lawn irrigation system, please locate, disconnect and remove any sprinkler heads within the public road allowance at the shaft site locations. Halton Region will reimburse you for the reinstallation of the removed irrigation systems.
- **Water and Wastewater Services** - There may be some disruption to water and wastewater services at various times throughout the course of the project. You will receive written notice of any scheduled shutdowns or disruptions, a minimum of 48 hours before the disruption occurs.
- **Night Work** – Night work may be required as part of this project. You will be notified in advance of any change in work hours.
- **Dust and Mud** - Due to the nature of the work, there may be increased levels of dust and mud near the work site. The contractor is required to manage these impacts.

This project is part of *Building a Better Halton*, the Region’s infrastructure construction plan for roads, water, wastewater, and waste management projects across Halton Region. For more information on Regional construction projects, visit www.halton.ca/construction.
